#### AMBULANCE RATE INCREASE 2021 - GREEN BAY METRO

Ryan Gibbons, Assistant Chief

- Explained the proposed Green Bay Metro Fire Department (GBMFD) Ambulance Rates
- LifeQuest Services provides ambulance billing services for the GBMFD and recommended:
  - The GBMFD add a SCT (Specialty Care Transport) Base Rate as this service is becoming more frequent during the pandemic for ambulances to transfer patients between facilities.
  - That a lift assist fee be established for staffed care facilities (i.e. Nursing Home and Assisted Living).
