Whereas, the Village of Allouez would like to continue being recognized as a member of Tree City USA by the National Arbor Day Foundation; and

Now Therefore, we, the Village Board of Allouez, do hereby proclaim the 25th day of April, 2014, as Arbor Day in the Village of Allouez, and urge all Citizens to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands and to support the Village's Forestry Program;

And Furthermore, we urge all Citizens to plant trees to gladden the hearts and promote the well being of present and future generations.
