Re: Snow on Streets

Date: March 20, 2014

It was brought to my attention by the street foreman that private contractor snow plows were pushing snow and ice from driveways in cul-de-sacs upon the center islands which are Village property. Also the pushing of snow across a street causes snow lines which stop snow drifts, freeze and creates road bumps. These are dangerous to motor vehicles and can cause damage to Village heavy equipment.

Village Board is asked to amend the ordinance allowing for changes to the Street & Sidewalk ordinance covering Snow on Streets.

3.20 SNOW ON STREETS.

A. No person shall throw or place any snow or ice upon any sidewalk, alley, or street. The deposit of any snow upon any sidewalk, alley, or street shall be a nuisance, and in addition to the penalty provided, the Village may summarily remove any snow so deposited and cause the costs of the removal to be charged to the owner of the property from which the snow has been removed.

B. A person owning or occupying the whole or part of a building or land abutting public streets in the Village of Allouez is hereby prohibited from moving snow, debris or any injurious substance onto or across such public streets and road rights-of-way at any time unless such a person has received permission from the Village to do so.

C. No person shall throw, divert or place snow or ice upon the cul-de-sac islands or roundabouts at any time unless such a person has received permission from the Village to do so.
