Re: Updating Ordinance 5.03 Parking of Watercraft, Utility Trailers, Motor Homes, Recreational and Commercial Vehicles and Equipment

Date: January 8, 2014

I have seen several watercraft trailers parked in driveway and in yards the last few weeks. It is my understanding that the intent of the ordinance was that there is a time frame for each seasonal use trailer to be parked during certain months each year. As it is written now, watercraft trailer are allowed to be parked year round at residence.

The concern with the current ordinance is the DNR schedule indicates that fishing season in certain areas is open continuously, which allows the residents of Allouez to keep their watercraft trailers parked in the driveway year round. A suggestion would be to set specific dates to prohibit the parking of watercraft trailers; suggested to be November 15th to the 1st of March the following year.

Below is a section of the revised Ordinance 5.03 Parking of Watercraft, Utility Trailers, Motor Homes, Recreational and Commercial Vehicles and Equipment. The highlighted section explains when watercraft trailer are permitted to be parked.

a. Seasonal use trailers for motorcycles shall be permitted to park in the driveway or side yard from March 1st through November 15th. Seasonal use trailers for watercraft shall be permitted to park in the driveway or side yard from March 1st through the end of the open water fishing season as published by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Seasonal use trailers for snowmobiles shall be permitted to park in the driveway or side yard from November 1st through March 31st. Seasonal use trailers for all-terrain vehicles shall be permitted to park in the driveway or side yard year round provided that the all-terrain vehicle is actually being used as opposed to parking merely for storage purposes. No watercraft, snowmobile, or all-terrain vehicle shall be stored in the driveway or side yard of a residentially or commercially zoned property as herein permitted except upon a seasonal use trailer. In the event that the seasonal use trailer is not being utilized for the storage of watercraft, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles or snowmobiles and is otherwise empty, it may be stored in the driveway or side yard year round.
