

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2014-13

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE
100.09 BOARDS AND COMMITTEES
AMENDING SECTION 100.09D(3), THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

The Village Board of the Village of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That this Ordinance shall constitute a charter ordinance as defined by §66.0101(1m), Wisconsin Statutes, and shall not take effect until sixty days after its passage and publication as a Class 1 notice; and, in the event that within such sixty-day period a Petition signed by a number of electors of the Village equal to not less than 7% of the votes cast within the Village of Allouez for Governor at the last general election shall be filed in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of this Village demanding that this Ordinance be submitted to a vote of the electors, this Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

SECTION 2. That the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Allouez is hereby amended to read as follows:

100.09 BOARDS AND COMMITTEES.

D. Committees and Commission.

- (3) The PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE shall consist of three ~~regular members,~~
~~board members and two citizen members,~~ with the Village
Administrator, and ~~the~~ Public Works Director serving as staff
liaisons to the committee. The ~~regular board~~ members shall ~~be~~
~~Trustees of the Village, each of whom shall~~ be appointed annually
for a 1-year term. Citizen members can be appointed for three-year
terms; except that, initial appointments shall be for one 3-year
term and one 2-year term.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to §66.0101(2)(a), Wis. Stats., the enactment of this charter ordinance requires a two-thirds vote of the members-elect of the legislative body of the Village.
