## **CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2014-13**

## AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE 100.09 BOARDS AND COMMITTEES AMENDING SECTION 100.09D(3), THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

The Village Board of the Village of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1**. That this Ordinance shall constitute a charter ordinance as defined by §66.0101(1m), Wisconsin Statutes, and shall not take effect until sixty days after its passage and publication as a Class 1 notice; and, in the event that within such sixty-day period a Petition signed by a number of electors of the Village equal to not less than 7% of the votes cast within the Village of Allouez for Governor at the last general election shall be filed in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of this Village demanding that this Ordinance be submitted to a vote of the electors, this Ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

**SECTION 2.** That the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Allouez is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 100.09 BOARDS AND COMMITTEES.

- D. Committees and Commission.
  - (3) The PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE shall consist of three regular members, board members and two citizen members, with the Village Administrator, and the Public Works Director serving as staff liaisons to the committee. The regular board members shall be Trustees of the Village, each of whom shall be appointed annually for a 1-year term. Citizen members can be appointed for three-year terms; except that, initial appointments shall be for one 3-year term and one 2-year term.

**SECTION 3**. That pursuant to §66.0101(2)(a), Wis. Stats., the enactment of this charter ordinance requires a two-thirds vote of the members-elect of the legislative body of the Village.
