Date: December 31, 2013

Brown County completed the All Hazards Mitigation Plan in July of 2013. The plan covers the entire Brown County area including the Village of Allouez. You were sent the link to the plan in early December.

The plan basically allows the village to qualify for federal assistance in the case of a local disaster. The plan is also used to meet one of the requirements of our Flood plain certification (CRS Rating).

The Village Board is asked to pass the resolution in support of the Brown County, Wisconsin 2012 All Hazards Mitigation Plan.

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BROWN COUNTY ALL HAZARDS
MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Village of Allouez recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects and to retain our CRS Floodplain rating.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Allouez, Wisconsin, hereby adopts the *Brown County All Hazards Mitigation Plan* as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon approval of the *Brown County All Hazards Mitigation Plan*, the Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission, on behalf of the Brown County Emergency Management Department, will submit the adopted plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval, as required under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
