Whereas, Historic Preservation Month can instill awareness of the local historically significant buildings and landmarks to the residents of Allouez and surrounding communities; and


Whereas, Historic Preservation Month can promote the region's largest source of heritage tourism, Heritage Hill State Historical Park, located in the Village of Allouez; and

Whereas, Historic preservation has been shown as a great way to create jobs, stabilize property values, and preserve existing housing stock;


