To the Village of Allouez Board:

The Lorelei Inn has set the date for our 2015 Oktoberfest Celebration.

The date is September 25, 2015 3:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. and September 26, 2015 from noon until 9:00 p.m. This is a request to extend our liquor license to our outdoor event and also obtain a noise variance until 10:00 p.m. We were hoping that we could close off the road from the east intersection of Allouez Place to Webster Ave and to the end of our parking lot entrances. The road would only be closed with movable barriers so any emergency vehicles would have access. Our celebration has grown the past three years and more often than not, the crowds are spilling out into the road. If this road was closed to through traffic, it would further allow the safety of the crowd. We borrow the moveable barriers from Cellcom so they are very sturdy barriers and are also easily moved. We have also employed a security firm to provide safety and protection for our business and also our customers. Last year we had four paid security personnel and this year we are planning on four again this year so we can cover all sections of the tent. They would also be patrolling the road if we were able to close it. It would be a great advantage if we were able to close this road.

Last year as in the previous years, we did not charge a cover charge and the entrance to the event was staffed with Allouez Kiwanis Members who checked identification and applied wrist bands. There was no cover charge, but a donation jar. Once again, we were able to present \$1000.00 to the Allouez Kiwanis Leonard Hack Memorial Scholarship Fund; \$500.00 to the March of Dimes in Memory of Carston and Emmet Arps; \$500.00 to the CP Center; \$500.00 to the Miracle League Playground; \$300.00 to the Allouez Beautification Committee; \$200.00 to the Allouez Firefighters and \$500.00 to the Green Bay Animal Rescue. We are trying more and more to keep the donations in Allouez.

We are anxiously looking forward to Oktoberfest this year. We feel very positive about the effect this has for Allouez. We look forward to working with you again this year to make this a great event.
