5. The permittee at its sole cost shall obtain and maintain general liability insurance for the activity in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 for damages arising out of personal injuries to any one person and \$250,000.00 for damages to property, in any one accident...

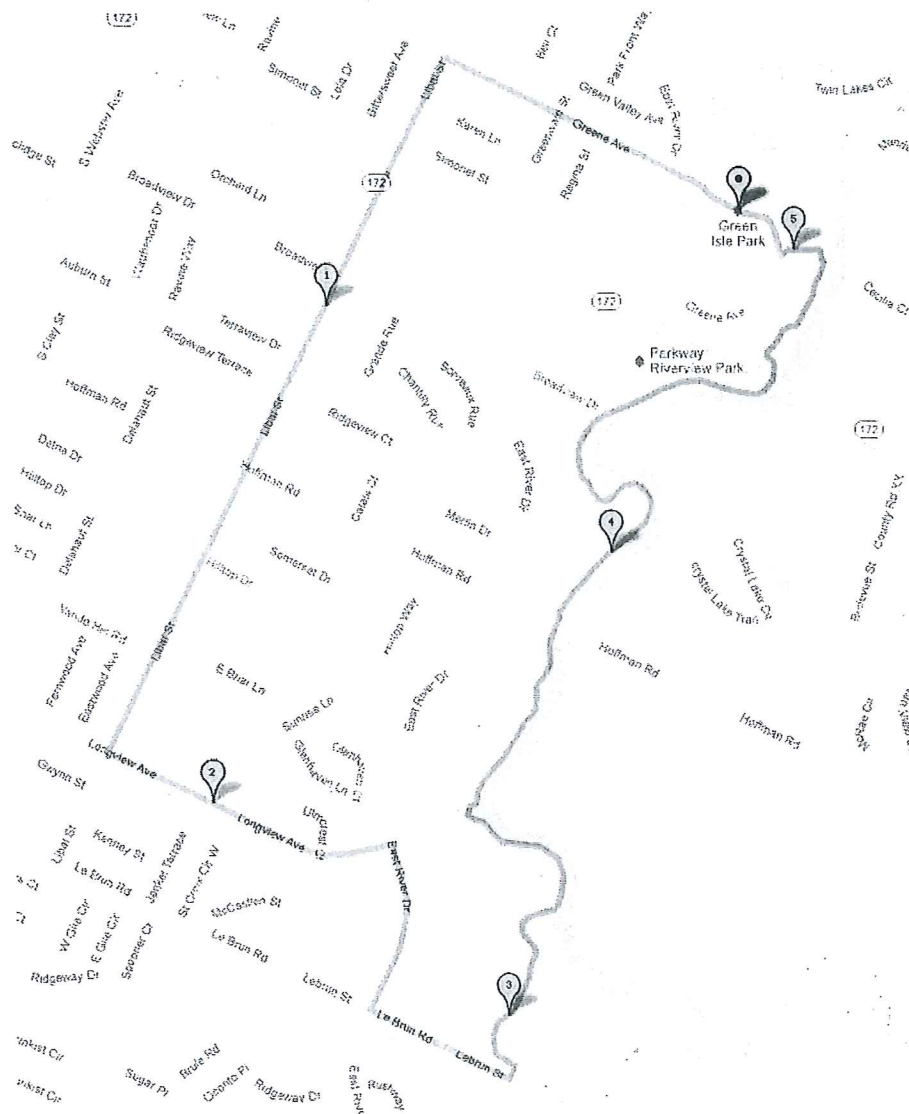
Gold Ribbon Run 2M Map



Race Directions

Both the 2 & 5 Mile races start in Green Isle Park. 2 & 5 Mile racers head west out of the park on Greene Avenue to Libal Street. Runners will head south on Libal Street to Broadview Drive. At this point, the 2 and 5 Mile courses split. 2 Mile racers will head east on Broadview. 2 Mile racers will continue east on Broadview to East River Drive. At East River Drive, runners will turn north for a short distance, and head for the south entrance to Green Isle Park. Runners will follow this road through the park to the finish line.

Race Directions

Both the 2 & 5 Mile races start in Green Isle Park. 2 & 5 Mile racers head west out of the park on Greene Avenue to Libal Street. Runners will head south on Libal Street to Broadview Drive. At this point, the 2 and 5 Mile courses split. 2 Mile racers will head east on Broadview and 5 Mile racers will continue south on Libal to the intersection of Libal and Longview. At Longview, runners will head east to East River Drive. At East River Drive, runners will turn south a short distance to the intersection of East River Drive and LeBrun. At LeBrun, turn east and race past the Allouez yard waste drop site, and head to the East River Trail. Runners will head north on the picturesque trail all the way back to Green Isle Park and the finish line. There will be corner workers and signage directing you at major course turns. Water stops are available at the $\frac{3}{4}$, $2\frac{3}{4}$ and $3\frac{3}{4}$ Mile marks.
