## RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ELIMINATION OF THE GREEN BAY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION'S THIRD SHIFT GUARD TOWERS

**WHEREAS,** Governor Walker has proposed in his biennial budget the elimination of the 3<sup>rd</sup> shift guard towers; and

**WHEREAS**, said budget proposal would impact guard towers at the Green Bay Correctional Institution; and

**WHEREAS**, Green Bay Correctional Institution is located in a residential neighborhood within the corporate boundary of the Village of Allouez and is literally in the backyard of several residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Green Bay Correctional Institution was constructed over 100 years ago and has limitations for improvements for ground patrol; and

**WHEREAS,** technology changes alone will not secure the safety and security of the public and correctional employees; and

**WHEREAS**, Green Bay Correctional Institution should be compared to Waupun Correctional Institution and thus have the necessary staffing retained until January 1, 2017;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village Board of Trustees hereby requests that the 3<sup>rd</sup> shift guard towers located in the Village of Allouez remain open for the safety and security of our citizens and correctional employees.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this Resolution be provided to the Honorable Governor Walker, Secretary of Corrections Wall, Senator Cowles and Representative Steffen.
