Funding Options for Christmas Decoration Street Display

Date: July 21, 2015

Background Information:

The Village of Allouez has embarked in providing holiday decorating along village streets this year. As you may recall, the Village had received close to 125 street pole decorations at no charge from Downtown Green Bay, Inc. earlier this year. Some of these decorations are usable as is, however most are in need of some repair and we would like to replace all of the light bulbs with energy efficient LED bulbs as well.

Initially our thoughts are to install a portion of these decorations along Webster Avenue (Allouez Avenue north to the railroad tracks), and then phase in other locations each year as budget and street reconstructions allow. This initial stretch would have around 30 decorations installed on both sides of the street. Other locations of interest include other areas of Webster Avenue, Riverside Drive, Green Isle Park, the roundabouts at Allouez Avenue and Hoffman Road.

In addition to efficient bulbs, we will need to budget for decoration hanging brackets, electrical festoons (outlets), photo eyes/timers, electrical usage, and staff labor.

Staff will also need to work with Wisconsin Public Service to obtain permission to install decorations on their power poles. This is a standard practice that any community has to go through before installation of decorations or banners on the poles.

Budget Item/Funding:

As this initial location along Webster Avenue is within the TIF District, we are requesting the use of TIF funding not to exceed \$15,000. Future funding can be included in the village Capital Improvement Program to be worked out during the budget process.

The number of decorations installed could be scaled back if the board wishes to allocate a lesser amount of funding for this project in 2015.
