Re: APPROVAL OF BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN AD HOC COMMITTEE

Date: July 2, 2015

The Plan Commission recommended in May the creation of an ad hoc committee charged with creating a Comprehensive Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan for the village. Staff reached out to community members, representing all skill levels and needs relative to walking and bicycling, with the intent of forming a committee of 10-12 interested community members.
