Dear Ms. Cepeda:

As you know, Statewide Services, Inc. administers the claims for the League of Wisconsin Municipalities Mutual Insurance, which provides the insurance coverage for the Village of Allouez. We are in receipt of the above-captioned subrogation claim in which the claimant is asserting damage paid to their policyholder, Thomas Elroy, as a result of a sewer backup.

Our investigation has revealed that the Village was not negligent for this incident; therefore, we recommend that the Village disallow this claim pursuant to the Wisconsin Statute for disallowance of claim 893.80(1g). The disallowance of the claim in this manner will shorten the statute of limitations period to six months.

This loss occurred due to a plug of an unknown substance in the sewer main. However, the Village did not cause the plug with their operations; and Village staff had no prior notice of the plug so as to take measures to prevent any damage. Once Village staff was alerted to the problem, they immediately responded to clear the plug in order to mitigate damage, thus no liability for damage can be attributed to the Village on account of any delayed response.

Please send your disallowance, on your letterhead, directly to the claimant at the above listed address. This should be sent certified or registered (restricted) mail and must be received by the claimant within 120 days after you received the claim. Please send me a copy of your letter for our file.
