On Thursday, January 28, 2016, at approx. 7:00am, I, Direct Enforcement Officer Jason Vogel, spoke in person with Andrew Fabry at 218 Miramar Dr. in reference to his Noise Variance Permit Application. The application is asking for noise variance until 11pm on June 18, 2016. I issued Andrew a copy of the Village of Allouez Regulation of Noise (31.01). Andrew showed me the back yard of 226 and 218 Miramar Dr. where the wedding will be held. Andrew explained there will be 2 large tents with one holding a dance floor and DJ. This tent will be located in the northeast corner of the back yard. Andrew states they will instruct the DJ to point the speakers west and north towards the Fox River and Allouez Catholic Cemetery. Andrew states he will personally try to contact the neighbors next to him on Old Allouez Ct to notify them of this event. Andrew states he will also contact the neighbors directly across the street on Du Charme Ln. Andrew stated he grew up in this neighborhood. Andrew states they will have a designated person walk around the neighborhood while the DJ is playing to make sure the music is not a disturbance. Andrew stated he will be at the Village of Allouez Board Meeting on Feb. 2, 2016, to answer any questions/concerns the board may have for him at that time.

I later spoke with 4 of the 5 tenants on Old Allouez Ct. All 4 stated they had no problem with the wedding DJ playing until 11pm. The people I spoke to are #118 John Bradley, #120 Bob Kluck, #122 Rita Houston, and #126 Jim Regan. A female named Jerri lives in #124 and did not answer the door. Two different neighbors stated Jerri is very hard of hearing and they didn't think it would be an issue with the noise/music with her.

At this time I am requesting an approval for this Noise Variance Permit Application.

## 5.07 SOUND AMPLIFIERS.

The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the village. A sound amplifier shall not be operated before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. or in the vicinity of churches while services are being conducted, or near schools that are in session. The village may order a reduction in the volume of an amplifier on complaint being made by a citizen, or when such loud speaker is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.
