To the Village of Allouez Board:

The Lorelei Inn has set the date for our 2016 Oktoberfest Celebration for September 23-24, 2016.

This is a request to extend our liquor license to our outdoor event. We also realize that we need to comply with the noise ordinance. We were hoping that we could close off the road from the east intersection of Allouez Place to Webster Ave and to the end of our parking lot entrances. The road would only be closed with movable barriers so any emergency vehicles would have access. Our celebration has grown the past two years and more often than not, the crowds are spilling out into the road. If this road was closed to through traffic, it would further allow the safety of the crowd. We borrow the moveable barriers from Cellcom so they are very sturdy barriers and are also easily moved. We have also employed a security firm to provide safety and protection for our business and also our customers. Last year we had four paid security personnel and this year we are planning on going to eight so we can cover all sections of the tent. They would also be patrolling the road if we were able to close it once again. New this year is that Bellin Hospital has given us permission to use their parking lots on St Joseph and we are planning to run a shuttle. The details are still being worked out but we will keep you informed.

Last year as in the previous years, we did not charge a cover charge and the entrance to the event was staffed with Allouez Kiwanis Members, Green Bay Animal Rescue volunteers and most impressively by the CP Center who brought several of their clients along who were personally thanking people for their donations. Once again, we were able to present \$1000.00 to each the Allouez Kiwanis Leonard Hack Memorial Scholarship Fund; \$1000.00 to the Miracle League Field in Allouez; \$1500.00 to the CP Center; \$1000.00 to the Green Bay Animal Rescue; \$1000.00 to the Altrusa House; \$500.00 to the Allouez Beautification Committee; \$300.00 to the Allouez Parks Committee; Green Bay Curling \$30.00; \$600.00 to soccer leagues; and some smaller donations are being made for summer recreation programs in the area.

We just did a running tally of donations for the last four years and the total exceeds \$20,000.00.
