

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 100.09 OF CHAPTER 100, ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE AND AMENDING SECTION 424-3 OF CHAPTER 424, LANDMARKS AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION, RELATING TO THE MAKE-UP OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMITTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ MUNICIPAL CODE

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN THAT SECTIONS 100.09 AND 424-3 BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

CHAPTER 100, ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE

100.09 Boards and Committees

(D)(5) The Historical Preservation Committee shall consist of six regular members, none of whom shall hold any other public office in the Village and one Village of Allouez Trustee. seven (7) members. Of the membership, if available in the community, one shall be a registered architect;and one shall be a licensed real estate broker and five shall be citizen members. Each member shall have, to the highest extent possible, a known interest in historical preservation. Appointments for the six regular seven members shall be for three year terms, except that initial appointments shall be for two - 3 year terms, three - 2 year terms and two - 1 year terms. The appointment for the Village of Allouez Trustee shall be made annually along with the appointments of the other village trustees who serve on committees/boards/commissions.

SECTION 2.

CHAPTER 424, LANDMARKS AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION

424-3 Historic Preservation Committee

A Historic Preservation Committee shall consist is hereby created, consisting of six regular members, none of whom shall hold any other public office in the Village and one Village of Allouez Trustee. seven (7) members. Of the membership, if available in the community, one shall be a registered architect;and one shall be a licensed real estate broker, and five shall be citizen members. Each member shall have, to the highest extent practicable, a known interest in historic preservation. The Village President shall appoint the committee, subject to confirmation by the Village Board.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
