**UWGB Park and Wayfinding Sign Designs**

### **Background Information:**

The community visioning sessions held in early 2015 and the recently completed Riverside Drive and Webster Avenue Corridor Study both call for creating a sense of place in the community and distinguishing Allouez from the rest of the greater Green Bay area. The corridor study recommends installing community identifiers (e.g. gateway signs, banners, water tower) and wayfinding signage to create that sense of place and distinction. In addition to installing these new signs, the Parks Department is also looking to incrementally change out the parks signs over the next ten to fifteen years.

When thinking about both of these projects, it should be considered creating a common theme that the village could adopt when installing these signs that would not only provide direction to destinations in the village, but also distinguish Allouez from the rest of the greater Green Bay area.

### Previous Information/Action:

Earlier this year, students from a UWGB graphic design class worked on this project with guidance from staff. They presented their concepts to the Board on April 19<sup>th</sup> and at that time no actions were taken.

### Budget Item/Funding:

Some of the park signs have been funded for 2016 in the CIP, with additional park signage funded through the CIP using an annual replacement program. Depending on the location of community identifiers and wayfinding signs, these signs will likely be future budget items or possibly TID expenses.

### Staff Recommendation:

Staff is looking for direction from the Board on a design theme to use on all future village signage so that we can begin with park sign replacements as well prepare budgets for FY2017.
