Re: Stadium Tax Refund

The Village Board and staff have been gathering, as best as possible, interest from our Allouez residents and committees on what the Village should do with the excess stadium tax refund. There have been multiple times in which the public could present their ideas to the Village Board at public meetings, committees have discussed ideas and most recently, a survey was provided online for the residents to complete. Our residents were informed of the survey via direct mailing and social media in order to engage our residents in the decision of how to best use the funds. I have attached the "running list" of ideas from board and committee meetings and the results of the survey that closed on June 30, 2016.

I would recommend that discussion/decision on how to use the funds be placed on a future agenda.






