ORDINANCE NO. 2016-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 23.10 OF CHAPTER 23, REGULATION OF FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES AND INTOXICATING LIQUORS, RELATING TO THE OUTDOOR FENCING AND/OR GATES USED TO CORDON OFF AN EXTERIOR PATIO AREA

SECTION 1. The Village Board of the Village of Allouez, Brown County, Wisconsin, does ordain that Section 23.10, be amended to read as follows:

23.10 ISSUANCE AND DURATION OF LICENSES.

Inspection of Application and Premises. The Village Clerk shall notify the Directed A. Enforcement Officer, Fire Chief and the Building Inspector of all licenses and permit applications. The Building Inspector and Fire Chief shall inspect each application and premises to determine whether the applicant and the premises sought to be licensed comply with the regulations, ordinances and laws applicable thereto and the applicant's fitness for the trust to be imposed. NOTE: All outdoor fences and/or gates used to cordon off an exterior patio area of bar/restaurant and will be located in the path of egress, must meet all current building and fire code egress/exit path requirements. The Fire Chief and Building Inspector shall furnish to the Village Clerk, in writing, the information derived from such investigation. The Directed Enforcement Officer shall furnish a report to the Village Board concerning any law violations relating to the application and premises including but not limited to the Village's Municipal Code, Chapter 125 and other Wisconsin Statutes. No license or permit provided for in this article shall be issued without the approval of the Village Board. The provisions of Chapter 125, Wis. Stats. and Chapter 23, Allouez Municipal Code shall apply to the approval and/or nonrenewal of licenses subject to Chapter 23.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication.
