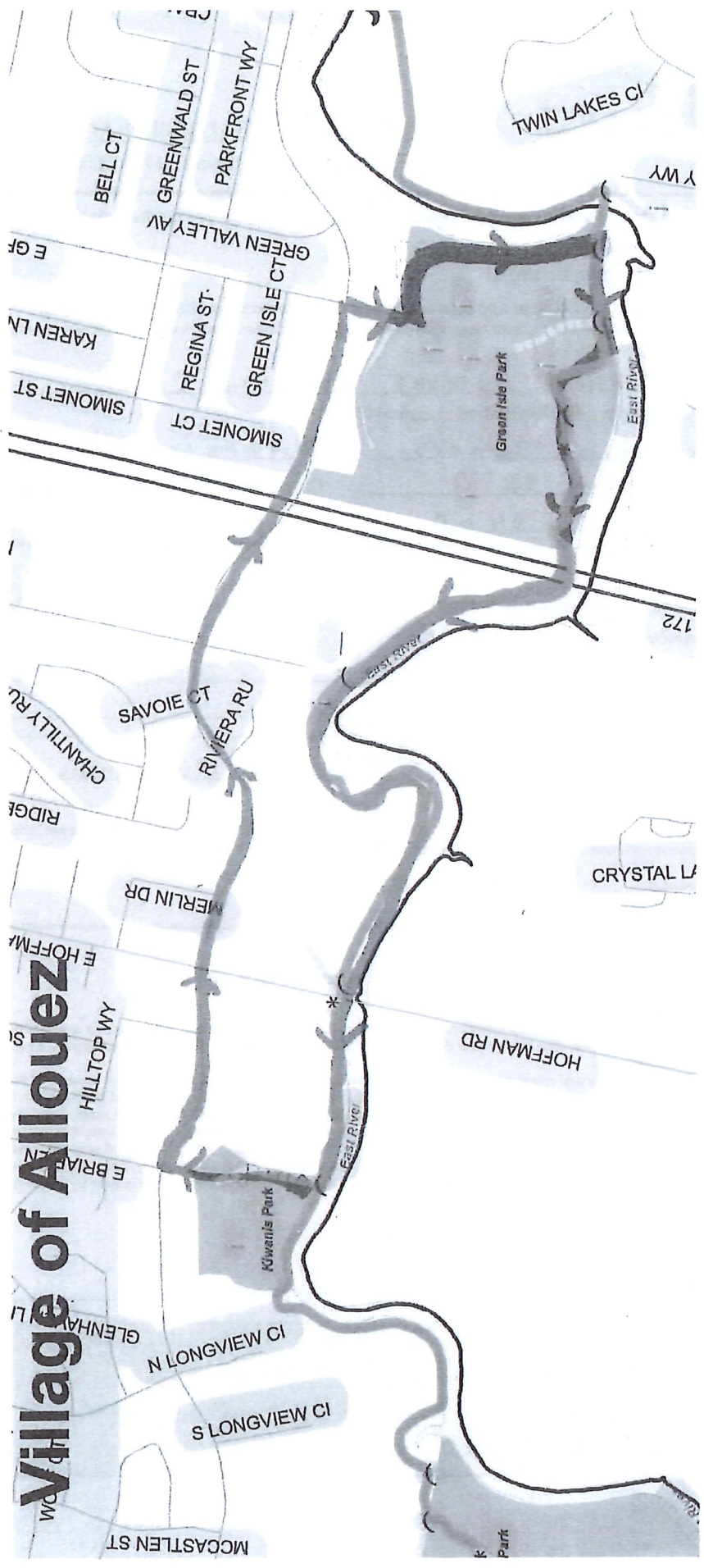
Conditions of Permit:

- 1. All street intersections along the event route are to be supervised by person 19 years of age or older.
2. Events will allowed only during daylight hours.
3. No events will be allowed during regular week day rush hours.
4. The Village of Allouez will not provide barricades for any events; however the Village will provide traffic cones on an availability basis.
5. The permittee at its sole cost shall obtain and maintain general liability insurance for the activity in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 for damages arising out of personal injuries to any one person and \$250,000.00 for damages to property, in any one accident, and shall furnish the Village with a certificate of insurance naming the Village as an additional insured not less than five (5) business days prior to the start of the event.
