

“The Kellogg Bridge” (no explanation provided)

Robinson Hill Bridge (the bridge goes over the railroad tracks that form the southern boundary for the Robinson Hill District. This District is a candidate for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and will soon be going through the nomination process. The District is essentially contained between Webster and Riverside Drive, the railroad and the Odd Fellows Home and represents excellent examples of prevailing architecture of the period from 1910 to 1940. The bridge forms a kind of “gateway” into this historic neighborhood.)
