Absentee Voting & Registration Information for November 8th General Election

In-person absentee voting in the Clerk's Office began on Monday, September 26, 2016 through Friday, November 4, 2016 from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Monday – Friday) with the exception of November 3rd and 4th we will be open until 5:00 p.m.

Reminder: Photo ID is now required to receive a ballot.

To request an absentee ballot by mail, fill out an **absentee request application** or send us a letter requesting an absentee ballot (include your name, address, and signature). **Photo ID** must accompany your request unless you are requesting to be put on the indefinitely confined list, you are in the military, or are permanently overseas. Send your request to the Village Clerk, 1900 Libal Street, Green Bay, WI 54301. The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is Thursday, November 3, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

If you need to **register** you will need to provide **Proof of Residence**. Last day to register by mail is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 19, 2016 and the last day to register in person at the clerk's office is 5:00 p.m. on November 4, 2016.

Check out **My Vote Wisconsin** – you can register to vote, check your voter registration status, find your polling place, see what's on your ballot, request an absentee ballot (military and permanent overseas voters only), and check provisional ballot status.

Note: If you have not voted in four years you may need to register again.

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Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)
