It's that time again when our liquor license is due and the Lorelei comes to you with our requests for Oktoberfest 2017. This year the event will be held on September 22-23, 2017.

We are asking for an extension on our liquor license to be able to serve alcohol outside on those two days. We would also like to extend the noise ordinance until 10:00 p.m. This crowd is never ready to go at this time but believe me we are. Also again we would like permission to close the road with movable barriers. We have never had an issue with an emergency vehicle needing the road, but we do not want to assume.

Last year with the use of Bellin Hospital parking lot on Libal St. has brought in much positive feedback. Bellin is allowing us to use the lot again this year and we have a 40 person shuttlebus rented. It was a big asset last year with the bridge closed, but even with the bridge open we feel it added a measure of safety also to the event.

To date with the donations from the door we have donated:

\$1,000.00 Allouez Kiwanis Leonard Hack Memorial Scholarship;

\$1,000.00 Miracle League Playgroud in Allouez;

\$1,700.00 CP Center in Allouez;

\$1,000.00 Altrusa House;

\$1,000.00 Green Bay Animal Rescue;

\$1,500.00 Allouez Business Association Bridge Opening Event;

\$300.00 Allouez Parks Program;

\$300.00 Soccer program; and we still have funds left that will be dispersed as we have softball teams, etc., with summer leagues contact us.

This will make three years in a row the donations will be putting at least

\$10,000.00 back into the community and mostly Allouez. As best we can figure there

were over 4,000.00 people who attended. It gets a bit confusing as many attended both days so it could be more as they did not need new wristbands.
