On Saturday, April 29th, 2017, I, DEO Jason Vogel, reviewed the Noise Variance Permit Application completed by Doug Meikle, from the Four Season Tennis Club, located at 3600 Riverside Dr. Doug is applying for the date of Sunday, August 13th, 2017, for a band to play amplified music in the parking lot outside from the hours of 1pm to 4pm. All proceeds from this fundraiser will be donated to a reading program that serves the area. Doug has provided his contact information and is listed as the contact person if there is an issue. On Tuesday, May 2nd, 2017, I spoke with Doug in person who states the volume will be monitored to ensure a reasonable level of volume.
