## RESOLUTION REGARDING THE SPENDING OF THE EXCESS GREEN BAY/BROWN COUNTY PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL STADIUM DISTRICT SALES TAX

*WHEREAS*, On March 31, 2015 the Green Bay/Brown County Professional Football Stadium District Board completed the certifications necessary to end the football stadium district sales tax on September 30, 2015; and

*WHEREAS*, 2015 Wisconsin Act 114 provided a mechanism for football stadium district sales taxes collected or imposed between April 1, 2015 and September 30, 2015 to be paid back to Brown County and municipalities within Brown County; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Allouez received \$725,985; and

*WHEREAS,* The Village of Allouez adopted Resolution 2016-23 which allocated \$100,000 for the use of a controlled pedestrian crossing at the north end of Riverside Drive (pending approval by the State DOT and with an expiration date of July 31, 2017); and

*WHEREAS,* Due to the delay in the state budget being passed the Village extends the expiration date to October 31, 2017; and

*WHEREAS,* Through public input it was noted that our residents are interested in pedestrian crossings on Riverside Drive to gain access to the Fox River State Trail.

**NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village Board of the Village of Allouez, hereby approves, allocating \$100,000 for a controlled pedestrian crossing at the north end of Riverside Drive (pending approval by the State DOT) and with an expiration date of October 31, 2017.
