Re: ACTION RE: STREET SIGNS FOR MIRAMAR DRIVE

The Historic Preservation Committee has been working on nominating the Miramar Drive Residential Historic District to the State and National Registers of Historic Places. The district was successfully listed to the State Register on December 1, 2017. The nomination paperwork has been forwarded to the National Parks Service to be evaluated for the National Register.

If successfully listed to the National Register, it has been discussed replacing the standard green street signs with brown street signs, which tend to be indicative of National Register Historic Districts in other communities.

There would be six signs in total, which would include the three Miramar Drive signs between Webster Avenue and Riverside Drive, as well as the cross streets. The estimate received for the signs and the necessary new mounting equipment is around \$50.00 per sign, or \$300.00 for the complete project.

The Historic Preservation Committee is asked consider the project and make the motion of whether or not to recommend the project to the Village Board.
