2016 Statistics

- 29 fire calls / response time
- 1073 emergency medical responses / response time

2017

- Hoping to add another ambulance to the system
- Seeking additional personnel to staff the ambulance added at Station 7
- In the process of putting in a 4th Fire Marshall position

2017 Challenges

- Increased call volume
- Increased demands for new incident types (intentional acts)
- Training requirements
- **Fiber connection needed to the Allouez Fire Station**
