We were approached by a Fat Tire Tour(bicycle) of Green Bay represented by the coordinator Jason Manders. Jason informed me that Fat Tire Tours have been around 34 years originating in Milwaukee. Jason and his wife took over the event 4 years ago, and since have moved to Green Bay! This year will be the second ride in Green Bay. The ride is 20 miles and has multiple stops at Green Bay taverns, starting and ending at Ned Kelley's downtown. There will be between 110-150 riders depending on the weather. Jason, on the nice days, there can be quite a few day of signups.

So with the size of the Lorelei, we obviously can't accommodate that many people in the building, can we extend our liquor license out into the parking lot. They will have two tokens for our establishment for drinks, limited to two selections of beer, and or two cocktails. We will serve water and soda on the house. So the plan was to have the bar open for the non beer drinks served by our licensend bartender, and I will be outside serving two tap beers, and to monitor the drinks not leaving our property.

They promote, and ask for a \$3 max on the tokens, so by no means is this a big money maker for us. We look at as hopefully an introduction for some to The Lorelei and Allouez. And being a bicyclist myself, a bike riding promotion. Their stop at The Lorelei would be from 2-3pm next Wednesday, August 22!
