§ 302-5: The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the Village. The Village shall not grant a permit to use a sound amplifier during nighttime hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) or to operate such sound amplifier in the vicinity of health facilities, churches while services are being conducted, or schools which are in session. The Village may order a reduction in the volume of such sound amplification on complaint being made by a citizen or when such sound amplification is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.

Noise Variance Permit Application

On 9/27/18 I, Deputy J. Vogel, reviewed the Allouez Noise Variance Permit Application filled out by Michael Troup who resides at 421 St Mary's Blvd. Michael was not home on this date but I was later able to speak to him by phone. Michael explained his tent will be enclosed with the speakers pointing towards his house. Michael will have his cell phone on him at all times in case deputies need to get ahold of him. Michael explained this was an on-going event for approx. 9 years but his wife and him have not hosted a party like this for the last 3 years due to the event becoming so time consuming. Michael states most nearby neighbors have already been invited to attend and he will make efforts to invite the neighbors he has not already spoken to.

I explained to Michael this application would be reviewed on October 2nd at the Allouez Village Board Meeting starting at 6:30pm. Michael stated he would try to attend the meeting in case the Allouez Village Board members had any questions.

I was able to speak with multiple next door neighbors who approved of the application from 5pm to 9:30pm. The following listed approved the application.

It should be noted no one was home at 411 St Marys Blvd and 500 Arrowhead Dr. Both Gene and Peter stated this residence has been throwing this party for years and both have been invited to attend.

Data records show there was one noise complaint made at 421 St. Mary's Blvd. on 9/26/15 at approx. 10:15pm. Deputies report speaking with Michael in person who was cooperative and turned the music off at that time. A verbal warning was issued and deputies did not have to return to the address that night. Due to Michael's cooperation at this time and in the past I am recommending approval from the Allouez Village Board for this request from 5:00pm to 9:30pm on 10/13/18.
