825 Ontonagon Court  
Dispute of Bulk Waste Fee

The resident at 825 Ontonagon Court is disputing the fee billed to his property for the collection of excess bulk waste (6 cubic yards). The Village Code allows homeowners to place up to 2 cubic yards (Front End Loader Bucket) of bulk waste at the curb for the collection by the Village. Homeowner's are charged \$25 per cubic yard for bulk in excess of 2 cubic yards. Warnings are not provided to residents that place bulk in excess of 2 cubic yards. The Village Code along with information provided on the Village's website and All About Allouez Magazine is attached for your review and reference.

Limitations on the amount of bulk placed at the curb is necessary in order for the Public Works Department to stay on schedule and to collect bulk throughout the Village in a timely manner.

## Chapter 432. Waste Management

### Article I. Solid Waste

#### § 432-2. Collection limits and frequency.

- A. Residential garbage collection. Normal accumulation of garbage from residential patrons will be collected by the Village once each week. Patrons must use a garbage cart as provided by or purchased from the Village. Refer to the Village website for the map showing collection days.
- B. Residential recycling collection. Normal accumulations of collectible recyclables from residential patrons will be collected by the Village as a single stream (commingled and recyclables) pursuant to the published Village collection schedule.
- C. Bulk waste regular collection week. The Village will designate the first full week (no holiday) of most months for collecting bulk waste. During this week the Village will collect up to two cubic yards (a pile three feet by three feet by six feet) of rubbish, bulk waste and brown goods without charge. The term "brown goods" means furniture, mattresses, etc. Refer to the Village bulk waste/refuse collection schedule for the scheduled collection weeks. Bulk waste shall be placed at the curb for collection on the normal garbage collection day. Additional waste over two cubic yards placed at the curb during the bulk waste/refuse collection week will be picked up at an additional charge per cubic yard as determined by the Village (refer to Chapter **225**, Fees and Charges).
- D. Bulk waste noncollection week. A patron may request bulk waste collection during a noncollection week, such as a renter move-out, but collection is subject to the pickup charges as defined in Chapter **225**, Fees and Charges, of the Village Code. The patron must call the Village Hall to schedule the pickup and pay the appropriate fee per Chapter **225**. If a patron places bulk waste at the curb during a noncollection week and does not schedule and pay for a collection by the Public Works Department, a notice will be issued to the property owner to remove the bulk waste. If the bulk waste is not removed within 48 hours after the date of notice, the Village will pick up the items and the property owner will be charged according to Chapter **225** of the Village Code.
- E. Major appliances. Major appliances are not picked up by the Public Works Department. Major appliances can be taken to the LeBrun waste disposal site. As it is illegal to dispose of electronics in landfills, these devices can be taken to the LeBrun waste disposal site, a licensed recycler or the Brown County hazardous waste facility. Disposal fees apply for televisions and computer monitors.
- F. Commercial or manufacturing sources. Normal accumulations of garbage from commercial or manufacturing concerns shall be collected weekly by commercial hauler (s).

## **Bulk / Trash / Junk Pick-Up:**

Large trash items, up to two (2) cubic yards, that won't fit in your garbage cart will be picked up at no charge on your garbage day Monday through Thursday the *first full week* of most months. Refer to the Bulk Waste Collection Schedule above. The schedule will also be posted on the Village website and in the All About Allouez booklet. Bulk waste includes mattresses, furniture, sinks, and wood less than four (4) feet in length. If the amount of trash / junk is more than two (2) cubic yards, there is an additional charge for the larger volume and it will be billed to the resident. Non-collectible items include fluorescent light ballasts and lamps, mercury lamps, gas grill propane tanks, lead acid batteries, computers, microwaves, televisions, electronic equipment, tires, construction debris from remodeling, concrete and bricks. These items must be disposed of by the resident at the Brown County Solid Waste Transfer Station (construction debris, tires, appliances, and batteries), the Brown County Recycling Center Household Hazardous Waste Facility (electronic items, paint).

Please note that electronic equipment (TV's **[\$10 per TV]**, radios, microwaves, computers, etc.) and appliances (stoves, refrigerators, etc) may be taken to the Village of Allouez Yard Waste Site for drop-off at no charge *except for TV's*.

Do not place trash / junk at the curb during non-pickup weeks. Violators will be given a forty-eight (48) hour notice to remove trash / junk from the curb and if not removed the Village will pick it up at a charge. The minimum pickup charge during a non-collection week is two-hundred dollars (\$200).

If a trash / junk pickup is requested due to selling a house or moving, cleaning out a house, or moving out of an apartment, a pickup can be provided at a one-hundred dollar (\$100) minimum charge. Call the Village Hall to schedule.

## **Brush Pick-Up:**

Brush (branches, twigs) is picked up Monday through Thursday the second week of most months on your garbage day. Refer to the Brush Collection Schedule for the exact collection week. Brush should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your garbage collection day. Brush is not collected during November due to fall cleanup; and not in February, April, and December. Residents are encouraged to trim trees during May through August.

Brush may be taken to the Village Yard Waste Site on LeBrun Street during the regular operating hours. See the LeBrun Yard Waste Site Operation Schedule below or in All About Allouez booklet.

Please refer to the 2019 Schedule for Bulk Waste/Brush and Garbage/Recycling Collection included in this booklet. Due to the large collection volume and limited Village Staff, the collection schedules must be rigidly followed. Collection of bulk waste and brush at other off-schedule times can only be done on a limited basis, and the Village must charge for those pickups if requested by residents. Please refer to the following sections for more information.

**GARBAGE AND RECYCLING:**

Garbage collection is weekly (Monday thru Thursday) and follows the routes shown on the Village map on the Village website. Bins must be out at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your pickup day.

Keep the garbage & recycling bins at least four (4) feet apart and four (4) feet from any bulk waste. Place containers on the lawn or driveway before 6:00 a.m. on your collection day and remove them from the street by midnight on collection day. Per Village Ordinance, when the bins are not at the curb, they cannot be stored in front of any building, house, or garage. Bins must not be visible from the street.

Please fit all waste in the garbage bin, if your bins are too full and the lid does not close tightly, you need to purchase a larger bin. Extra garbage & recycling bins can be purchased at the Village Hall.

**BI-WEEKLY SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING:**

The Village uses bi-weekly single stream recycling. Residents are asked to use their *blue recycling cart* for all recyclables (glass, cans, paper, and plastic). All recyclables should be placed in one (1) cart. Refer to the enclosed schedule to confirm exact collection weeks because of holidays. Please put the garbage and recycling carts out at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your pickup day. Residents may use both the blue and green 65 gallon recycling carts if they need to. Replacement carts must be purchased from the village. **THE VILLAGE HAS A COLLECTION BOX**

**BULK WASTE: (TRASH/JUNK PICK-UP)**

Large trash items that won't fit in your refuse cart are picked up Monday thru Thursday on your regular garbage day: the first full week of most months. *Refer to the schedule on page 45.*

The Village will pick up to two cubic yards of bulk waste. More than that will be charged \$25.00 per cubic yard. Refer to the Bulk Waste Collection Schedule to confirm actual collection weeks. **Place Bulk Waste at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your garbage collection day, and leave four (4) feet between bulk waste & any garbage and recycling carts. No bulk waste is picked up in April and November because of spring and fall leaf collection.**

*Please do not put out bulk waste for collection during these months, as a notice of violation will be issued.* Bulk waste includes mattresses, furniture, sinks, and wood less than four (4) feet in length. Non-collectable items include fluorescent light ballasts & lamps, mercury lamps, gas grill propane tanks, lead acid batteries, computers, microwaves, televisions, electronic equipment, tires, construction debris from remodeling, concrete, & bricks. These items must be disposed of by the resident at the Brown County Solid Waste Transfer Station (construction debris, tires, appliances, batteries), the Brown County Recycling Center, or the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (electronic items, paint) at the Recycling Center.

Residents may drop off appliances such as stoves, water heaters, and Freon containing items including refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, water coolers, and dehumidifiers at the appliance drop-

**BRUSH PICK-UP:**

Brush is picked up Monday thru Thursday, the second full week of most months. Refer to the **Brush Collection Schedule**. Brush should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your garbage collection day. *Brush is not collected during February, April, November, and December. Residents may take brush to the Yard Waste Site during these months. Residents should do tree trimming during January, March, and May thru September to best fit the scheduled brush collection weeks.*

If tree trimming is performed by a contractor, the contractor must provide disposal of the brush. The Village will not collect brush from contractor's work. A special collection for Christmas trees will begin the second full week of January for one week. You do not need to call the Village to schedule tree pickup, but place your tree at the curb by Monday of this week. Brush may be taken to the Village Yard Waste Site on LeBrun Street during the regular operating hours. Please see the Yard Waste Site Operation Schedule on this page.

**SPRING CLEAN UP:**

Spring leaf and garden waste collection is the first through the third full weeks of April, and leaves and garden waste should be placed at the curb by Monday morning for collection during the week. Shrubs, roots, and garden waste (dead plants, stalks) can be combined and placed on the lawn next to and parallel with the curb. No bulk waste collection is provided in April due to the spring cleanup workload.

**CHRISTMAS TREE EXCHANGE:**

The Village of Albuez will conduct a Christmas tree exchange program where residents can drop off their old Christmas tree at the Le Brun yard waste site in exchange for a coupon for a tree seedling which can be picked up next spring. The tree exchange will be conducted on the 1st and 2nd Saturdays in January from 11am-1pm. Residents are encouraged to take advantage of this offer.



**FALL LEAF COLLECTION:** In mid-October and extends thru the week b Thanksgiving. Leaves should be placed on ti lawn next to the curb by Monday morning, b NOT IN THE STREET. The Village crews make pass thru the Village every 6-7 days. Beginning late October, the leaf baler will be used for colli Therefore, it is important that leaves be placed the curb by Monday morning, since leaf collect varies & does not always follow the garbage co schedule. Due to the large volume of leaves, b collection is continuous, especially in November leaves may be picked any day of the week. The collection schedule is posted on the Village we and is updated frequently. It is intended to prov a general guide as to when leaf collection will o in areas of the Village. There is no brush collect during November, so please do not mix brush & leaves together when placing at the curb, as th prevents the leaf collection from functioning.

**LEBRUN YARD WASTE SITE INFORMATION:**

Located on LeBrun Street near East Drive. For Albuez residents only. Grass clippings, leaves, brush and other garden material accepted. There is also a waste oil, electronic and appliance drop off site.
