## About Us and What We Do!

Here you'll find information about co-founders Molly and Morgan and their journey starting The Feminine Project and why this is an important cause. This page also talks about The Feminine Project's donation steps and how the mission is fulfilled.



The Feminine Project was founded by Molly Schneider and Morgan Christensen in 2017. The non-profit project was started after noticing that homeless shelters list feminine products as an immediate need and it seems to be an item that is never removed from the list. When talking to the local homeless shelters we discovered that menstrual supplies are a commonly overlooked item by people donating to the shelters. In addition, feminine care is not covered by any government aid and is a taxed product in most states. Throughout the country there have been many organizational changes in regards to the issue of taxing feminine products and providing free product dispensers in public places; many feel that both of these changes provide necessary rights to women. We are two high school seniors in a transitional time of our lives, and we wanted to find a way that we could help the cause directly and provide assistance while the legislation and changes are being discussed.

The mission of The Feminine Project is to provide feminine hygiene products for homeless women and teens of Green Bay. For homeless women, days on their period can be the hardest and most stressful when searching is required to find a hygiene product. In addition, without the proper sanitary supplies these homeless women risk unnecessary discomfort and infection.

The cost of menstrual supplies is \$70 per year and just a month of supplies is \$7. All money donated to the project is being used to buy feminine care products for homeless women and teens. The Feminine Project collects donations through our Go Fund Me page or our Amazon Wish-List (donations can be bought by people themselves and mailed directly to us). To this day, The Feminine Project has raised over \$4,000 and has received over 6,000 donated menstrual products. The feminine care products are distributed through Green Bay homeless shelters that specify a need for these products.

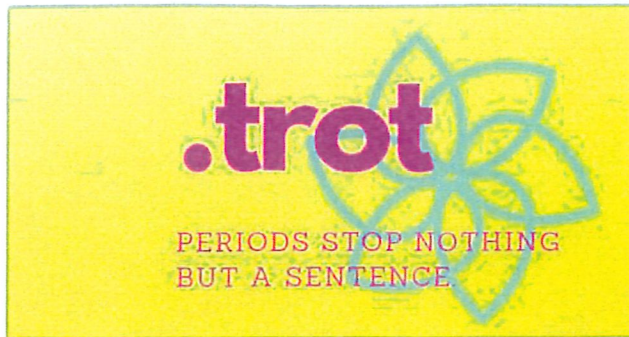
