I realize this is very short notice but we hope that our request can be granted.

We have not finalized any details of this endeavor, but waiting to see if this is possible.

We would like to have our liquor license special provisions for Oktoberfest extended a bit to include Sunday, September 22, from 11-4. So many people work the event we would like to do a "Empty the Barrels" option especially for service industry people. We would basically empty the tapped barrels and hopefully not tap any new barrels. We always have the issue after the event of the tapped barrels and keeping the cold and emptying them out. This would hopefully limit this problem. It would not be extensively advertised and we would only be using the side of the parking lot next to the Lorelei. There would be no bands brought in so noise would be minimal. We would be serving our limited Oktoberfest menu. It would only be staffed by our family members and limited employees. The service of liquor has not been evaluated. We would like to keep it to beer, soda and water at the present time, but would still like to keep the option open.

We have been asked about the fact that the tents are already in place could they be used to do an outdoor polka mass, by possibly one of the churches in Allouez and possibly do a booyah sale. That is a thought process for maybe next year but it could be a good fund raiser for a local church.

Once again the Allouez Lions and the Allouez Business Association have agreed to be bartenders/door attendants for the event which we are very grateful for.
