## LORELEI OKTOBERFEST 2019 UPDATE.

Another amazing year weather wise was given us for the 13<sup>th</sup> annual Lorelei Oktoberfest 2019. Very accurate counts were done this year. 3782 actual wristbands were used. But many of these people came back Saturday night and could use the same wristband, so we know in the two days we were over 4,000. There were absolutely no incidents or any need for law enforcement involvement. Our security people did an amazing job. But everyone was well behaved and were there to enjoy the music.

So, here is our proposal for the 14<sup>th</sup> annual Lorelei Oktoberfest. The tents cost us \$3000.00 They do not come down until Monday and they are unoccupied Sunday. We did not do our Empty the Keg idea as it was pouring rain on Sunday. I contacted the two Catholic churches in Allouez and was never able to reach someone at St. Matt's, but did talk to the Outreach Director at Ressurrection. Brought up the idea of both churches working together to do a polka mass under the tent followed by a booyah cookoff. Ressurection was incredibly excited about the idea plus asked about putting some games, etc., under the big tent. They are going to contact St Matt's and see if they are interested in a joint venture. They can keep the proceeds from the collection basket. The booyah cookoff would also donate back to the churches. We will cover the Sugarbusch Boys Polka Band cost. We would also serve brats, knackwurst, hot dogs like we do for Oktoberfest. At present we would only do beer, soda and water sales. I would like to have the option for an alcohol bar, but most church picnics are only beer venue. Details still need to be worked out in this so far and church members would be working the stands and compensation to them. This is still in the very rough stages as I need to know from the Village Board we would have permission to do this venture. Time frame would be like 11-4. The polka band would play into the afternoon also. So before we continue further, is this something you

would grant us permission to proceed with? Once we have approval, we can move ahead with other plans and I will keep you posted in that regards.

From all of us at the Lorelei, thank you very much for allowing us to continue with Oktoberfest. We are in the process of donating monies back out. For some reason, we just got behind closing this venue out this year.
