

Spring General on April 6, 2021

Request (by 5pm on April 1st) an absentee ballot be sent to you by either applying online at [MyVote.WI.gov](https://www.MyVote.WI.gov) or fill out and return an **application for absentee ballot** to the Clerk's Office.

-OR-

Vote in person at the Clerk's Office (1900 Libal Street) beginning March 23rd through March 31st from 8 am to 4 pm and April 1st and 2nd from 8 am to 5pm.

Reminder: **Photo ID** is required (if not on file) to request a mailed ballot and for voting in person

ACCEPTABLE PHOTO IDS FOR VOTING IN WISCONSIN

WHAT PHOTO IDS CAN I USE TO VOTE IN WISCONSIN?

State of Wisconsin Driver License  Can be expired since November 3, 2020 (currently the last General Election)	State of Wisconsin ID Card  Can be expired since November 3, 2020 (currently the last General Election)
Wisconsin Driver License OR State ID Card Receipt OR WI DMV ID Petition Process Photo Receipt  Valid for 45 days from the date receipt was issued OR 40 days for the ID Petition Process Receipt	Veterans Affairs ID  Must be unexpired or have no expiration
Student ID Card + Enrollment Verification (if expired)  Only valid for voting if the expiration date is no more than 3 years from the date the card was issued. Still valid for voting if expired.	U.S. Uniformed Services  Can be expired since November 3, 2020 (currently the last General Election)
Tribal ID Card  Still valid for voting if expired	Certificate of Naturalization  Only valid for voting if Certificate was issued not more than 3 years before the date of the election
