- WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products; and
- WHEREAS, trees in our Village increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and
- WHEREAS, trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and
- WHEREAS, Allouez has been recognized as a Tree City USA by The National Arbor Day Foundation and desires to continue its tree-planting ways,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, as President of the Village of Allouez, do hereby proclaim the 23rd day of April, 2021 as ARBOR DAY in the Village of Allouez, and I urge all citizens to support efforts to care for our trees and woodlands and to support our Village's urban forestry program, and
- FURTHER, I urge all citizens to plant trees to gladden the hearts and promote the well-being of present and future generations.
