6. ACTION RE: AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021

7. ACTION RE: FUTURE MAKE-UP AND STRUCTURE OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

President Rafter and staff met with a consultant, Platform Communications, to see what plan and materials can be created to move the decommissioning of Green Bay Correctional Institution in motion. Non-partisan materials will be created to give to state office holders and those running for office. Initial content is planned to be received by the village in June and will be sent to the Economic Development Committee.

9. DISCUSSION RE: VILLAGE OF ALLOUEZ SESQUICENTENNIAL (2023)

Staff is looking for input on what the village should do to celebrate its 150th birthday.

Discussion included:

- Can Heritage Hill do a yearlong celebration with other events?
- Connect with the established events in Allouez, like the Bellin Run and Allouezfest.
- The village will need to create a logo and promotional materials.
- Reach out to long-time residents and area historians for stories to share.
- Include long-serving businesses, like Schroeder's Flowers who have been in existence for 120+ years.
- Have a parade.
- Host different mini-celebrations at each park.
- Boat races on the rivers.

10. DISCUSSION RE: VILLAGE PROJECTS AND PROPERTIES UPDATE

A. Village Grants

- Applied for \$250k grant for project on Webster/St. Joseph.
- \$12k grant was received to nominate another historic district: Sunset Circle.
- Public works has applied for a few road work grants.

- A grant was written for the south end of Libal Street.

C. Development Projects

- Webster/St. Joseph still committed and moving forward.
- Seeing some projects put on hold because of cost increases.
