Re: Authorization to Purchase Gazebo for Optimist Park

Date: February 7, 2023

Background Information:

The Miracle League of Green Bay has secured donation funding from the Richard J Resch Foundation for the purchase and installation of a gazebo in Optimist Park. This funding is a reimbursement not to exceed \$75,000. Donor signage will be included with the project. This project was authorized in the 2023 Parks Capital Improvement budget.

The gazebo that we are requesting authorization to purchase is a Poligon Grand Haven steel structure that will be purchased through the Sourcewell Awarded Contract program. The program allows for discounted pricing by piggy backing on previously bid contracts.

The gazebo will be located on the south side of the park on the hill overlooking the active portion of the park. This will be a passive picnic shelter with no utilities. Anticipated completion of the project will be late summer or early fall of 2023.

Previous Information/Action:

- The Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Committee recommended authorization to proceed with the purchase of the gazebo at the January 31, 2023 meeting.
- This was also an authorized project in the 2023 Parks Capital Improvement budget. In addition, the installation of a gazebo at Optimist Park was included within the Village of Allouez Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan.

Budget Item/Funding:

The overall project is estimated at \$72,800 with the gazebo portion quoted at \$48,906. The remainder of the funds will be utilized for concrete work, decorative brick work around the posts, and donor signage. The funding will come out of the Parks Capital Improvement Fund and be reimbursed upon conclusion of the project.
