**Not able to get to the polls on Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>?**

**Prefer to vote early to avoid lines or in case of inclement weather? Vote Absentee!**

An absentee ballot can be mailed to you by applying online through [MyVote.WI.gov](https://MyVote.WI.gov) or by filling out and returning an [Application for Absentee Ballot](#) to the Clerk's Office. All mail requests must be received no later than March 30<sup>th</sup> by 5 pm.

Vote at Allouez Village Hall for in-person absentee voting located at 1900 Libal Street.
