An absentee ballot can be mailed to you by applying online through <u>MyVote.WI.gov</u> or by filling out and returning an <u>Application for Absentee Ballot</u> to the Clerk's Office. All mail requests must be received no later than March 30<sup>th</sup> by 5 pm.
