§ 302-5: The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the Village. The Village shall not grant a permit to use a sound amplifier during nighttime hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) or to operate such sound amplifier in the vicinity of health facilities, churches while services are being conducted, or schools which are in session. The Village may order a reduction in the volume of such sound amplification on complaint being made by a citizen or when such sound amplification is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.

Please extend our liquor license for these two days to include our outside parking lot. The bands would end at 10:00 p.m. On a side note, 2023 we were able to donate \$6000.00 back into the community. The CP Center, Altrusa House, Howe Community Center, Zion Lutheran School, Allouez Beautification, Pearly Gates Veterans, all received some donations. There are still some smaller donations not mentioned.

Dear Allouez Village Board Members,

RE: Lorelei Oktoberfest Event

On May 11th, 2023, I spoke in person with Dave Hack of the Lorelei Inn and reviewed their request for a Noise Variance permit application. The permit includes a request for live bands and tents set up for the dates of September 15-16th, 2023. The owners have an action plan that is very organized and well-thought out from the previous years of running this event and included the following items we reviewed:

1. There will be 2 tents located in the parking lots on the south side of the Lorelei Inn and Dave stated they did not have any traffic issues with Allouez Terrace last year. Allouez Terrace will be closed but the tents are moveable if an emergency presents itself.
2. 8+bouncers will be utilized to stop the possibility of underage drinkers with one main entry point for the tent.
3. Dave verified their action plan for the customers is after the music ends at 10:00pm, the patrons would be directed inside the tavern and out of the parking lots no later than 11:00pm.
4. Dave, Lynne, Meagan will be the contact people at the phone number provided if there are any problems concerning the Brown County Sheriff's Office.

A record check was performed on last year's 2022 Oktoberfest event. Only two parking complaints were made in the area. Due to the organizational plan and the low volume of parking complaints for a large event like this, I am recommending the Village Board approve this Noise Variance Permit Application.
