The Village of Allouez will be doing an update to the Comprehensive Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan (2018). This document identifies locations of physical infrastructure improvements that enhance bicycle and pedestrian connections in the village, as well as guides policy and decision making around bicycle and pedestrian programming.

The update project includes different public input opportunities. One opportunity includes creating an ad hoc steering committee made up of Allouez residents and stakeholders to provide input throughout the process. The timeline of creating and adopting the plan will likely be eight months, with the anticipated first meeting taking place in April 2024. The work is being performed by Brown County Planning and Land Services Department as part of a Federally funded transportation program. The Director of Planning and Community Development, Trevor Fuller, is the recommended village staff liaison to the committee. However, we will have ongoing dialogue with the Public Works Department, the Parks Department, the Brown County Sheriff office, and other relevant departments.
