
## **NOISE VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATION**

§ 302-5: The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the Village. The Village shall not grant a permit to use a sound amplifier during nighttime hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) or to operate such sound amplifier in the vicinity of health facilities, churches while services are being conducted, or schools which are in session. The Village may order a reduction in the volume of such sound amplification on complaint being made by a citizen or when such sound amplification is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024, I, Deputy J. Vogel, spoke with Stacy Smits from St. Matthews Parish, located at 130 St. Matthews St., about their annual parish picnic celebration to be held on June 2<sup>th</sup>, 2024, from the hours of 10:30am to 3:00pm. Stacy has recently completed a Village of Allouez Noise Variance Permit Application for said Parish event which will be held in their parking lot.

Stacy states the music speakers will be pointed away from houses and towards the church buildings. Stacy states the music will start after church ceremonies at 10:30am and stop at 3:00pm. Stacy states she will be attending and have her cell phone on her during the event in case the village or Brown County Sheriff's Office needs to get in touch with her for any concerns. Stacy is expecting approx. 300 people to attend.

In looking back at last year's event held on June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023, there were no complaints made to the Brown County Sheriff's Office about noise. Currently, I am recommending approval of this application.
